IATA 7.1 - Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) for Preparing DG Consignments - Initial

Introduction

This Training course is for personnel responsible for preparing Dangerous Goods Consignments as per IATA DGR section 1.5 and in accordance with the Competency-Based Training & Assessment (CBTA) approach for well-defined function 7.1. - Previously covered under categories 1 & 2.

Key topics

- Legal responsibilities of key stakeholders
- Understanding and applying relevant sections of the current IATA DGR
- Classification and identification of dangerous goods
- Required transport documentation: Dangerous Goods Declaration (DGD), air waybill
- Safety implications of packaging types, and net quantity limitations
- End-to-end communication of hazards and handling requirements using correct marks and labels
- Packing, marking and labelling requirements: UN
- Specifications, limited quantities and another packaging
- Reporting to appropriate authorities as required

COURSE DURATION

5 full days, starting at 9:00 each day and finishing approx. at 17.00 on the first four days. On the fifth day, the course will finish at approximately 16:00.

Personnel involved in preparing dangerous goods consignments:

- Shippers and packers
- Manufacturers and exporters of dangerous goods or products that contain dangerous goods
- Cargo agents, Consolidators and Freight Forwarder
