

TRAINING COURSE

ICAO TRAINAIR PLUS - Assistance to Aircraft Accident Victims and their Families (AAAVF EN)

Introduction

This course will provide CAA representatives, other government officials, aircraft and airport operators and nongovernmental organization with the competencies to effectively support aircraft accident victims and their family assistance efforts, in accordance with ICAO Policy on Assistance to Aircraft Accident Victims and their Families (Doc. 9998), and the ICAO Manual on Assistance to Aircraft Accident Victims and their Families (Doc 9973).

COURSE DURATION

4 days, starting at 09:00 and ending at approximately 17:00

LARGET GROUP

Primary Target Population:

This course is recommended for CAA representatives, other government officials, aircraft and airport operators and third parties (e.g. NGOs, commercial companies) for aircraft accident family assistance.

Secondary Target Population:

Staff from government agencies who have a role in aircraft accident investigation and response but may not be directly interfacing with family members following an accident.
