

TRAINING COURSE

ETSO (Annex Part 21)

Introduction

This course provides an overview of the European Technical Standard Order (ETSO) framework and its role in aviation safety and airworthiness. It explains how ETSO Authorisation enables the approval of aircraft parts and components independently of their installation, ensuring they meet defined technical standards. Participants will gain an understanding of the regulatory basis, including the relevant EASA requirements, CS-ETSO specifications, and the procedures outlined in Regulation (EU) No. 748/2012 - Subpart O. The course aims to build a solid foundation in ETSO principles and their practical application within the certification process.
