# EASA Air Operations for Helicopters

## Introduction

EU regulations impact National Aviation Authorities and commercial and non-commercial operators across the air operations domain. This course introduces the structure and basic principles of the regulations and covers the detailed scope of the requirements.

- Annex VIII - Specialised Operations (SPO)
