

# TRAINING COURSE EASA Air Operations for Helicopters

## Introduction

EU regulations impact National Aviation Authorities and commercial and non-commercial operators across the air operations domain. This course introduces the structure and basic principles of the regulations and covers the detailed scope of the requirements.

- → Annex VII Non-commercial Other-than Complex (NCO)
- → Annex VIII Specialised Operations (SPO)
